We influenced new legislation on judicial review to preserve judges' discretion and make sure claimants continue to receive fair outcomes.

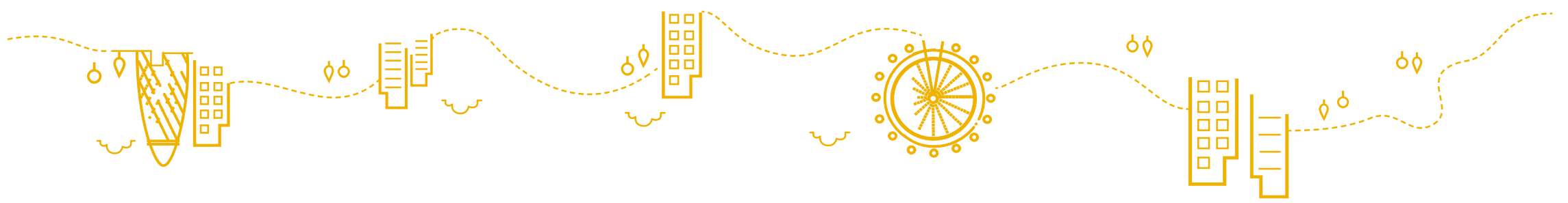

Why do we walk?

Everyone should have access to justice. In reality, not everyone does. Two-thirds of the UK population don't know how to get legal advice and 15 million people who live in poverty can't afford to pay for it. The COVID-19 pandemic, and emerging cost of living crisis is widening the justice gap further with 1.3 million people predicted to fall into absolute poverty next year.

Legal advice charities have worked tirelessly on the frontline to support individuals and families throughout the pandemic and beyond. Over the last two years, advice agencies have reported a six-fold increase in requests for help. Sadly, this urgent need has continued and been exacerbated by the rising cost of living and instability around the world, as people face life-changing issues around debt, housing, employment, Universal Credit, domestic violence, and more.

People need support to be able to access justice; challenge unlawful evictions, secure the care provision they are entitled to, and combat discrimination at work.

With over 100 legal aid providers lost over the course of the pandemic, the survival of free legal advice services is more urgent than ever. Decades of funding cuts and a drop in income due to the pandemic have pushed the surviving advice charities to the brink, and they need urgent funds so they can continue to provide a lifeline to their communities.

Every year, the London Legal Walk supports over 100 legal advice services in London and the South East. This year, they need us more than ever. Please help us to give everyone access to justice. - Adults and children who have been trafficked to the UK to become domestic or sex slaves.
 - People who have been unfairly dismissed or who are discriminated against at work.
 - Families living in terrible housing conditions.
 - People who are working for less than minimum wage.
 - People living with disability or illness, and their carers.
 - Elderly people who need support to stay living independently.

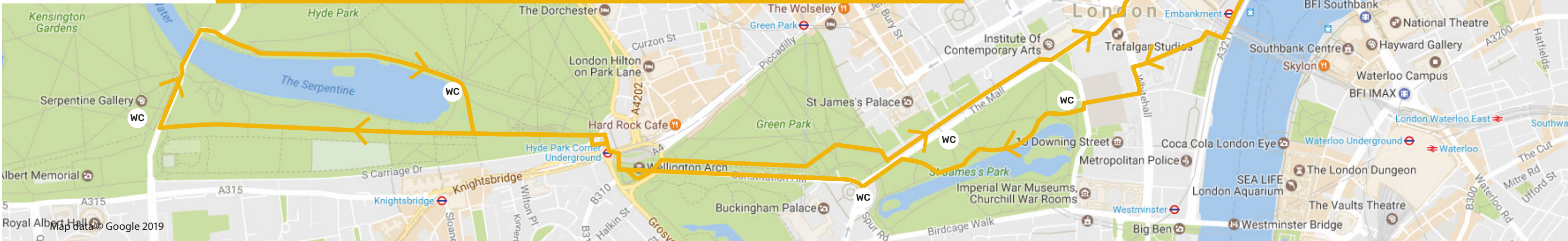
