Everyone should have access to justice. In reality, not everyone does.

Two-thirds of the UK population don't know how to get legal advice and 15 million people who live in poverty can't afford to pay for it. The COVID-19 pandemic, and emerging cost of living crisis is widening the justice gap further with 1.3 million people predicted to fall into absolute poverty next year.

Legal advice charities have worked tirelessly on the frontline to support individuals and families throughout the pandemic and beyond. Over the last two years, advice agencies have reported a six-fold increase in requests for help. Sadly, this urgent need has continued and been exacerbated by the rising cost of living and instability around the world, as people face life-changing issues around debt, housing, employment, Universal Credit, domestic violence, and more.

People who have been unfairly dismissed or who are discriminated against at work.


Families living in terrible housing conditions.




