Access to justice should be a right, not a privilege. Yet in the UK today, it remains out of reach for many. Two-thirds of the population don't know how to access legal aid, and 16 million people, nearly one in four, are living in poverty, the highest level recorded in the 21st century. The ongoing cost-of-living crisis is deepening this injustice: 4.2 million households are going without essentials such as regular meals, heating, toiletries, or adequate clothing. Shockingly, 3.4 million households can't even afford food. As everyday needs become luxuries, the justice gap continues to widen. As the gap widens, the need for free legal support is more urgent than ever.

Legal advice charities have worked tirelessly on the frontline to support individuals and families throughout the pandemic and beyond. Sadly, this urgent need has continued and been exacerbated by the rising cost of living and instability around the world, as people face life-changing issues around debt, housing, employment, Universal Credit, domestic violence, and more.

People need support to be able to access justice; challenge unlawful evictions, secure the care provision they are entitled to, and combat discrimination at work.

Every year, the London Legal Walk supports over 100 legal advice services in London and the South East. This year, they need us more than ever. Please help us to give everyone access to justice. Some examples include: Adults and children facing trafficking and labour exploitation.


People facing unfair dismissal or discrimination in the work place. Homeless people and families living in unacceptable housing conditions


