THANK YOU FOR SIGNING UP TO THE 2026 LONDON LEGAL WALK

The London Legal Walk is a 10km after-work walk, starting on Carey Street behind the Royal Courts of Justice. In 2025, over 19,000 walkers took part, once again raising over £1 million to support the provision of free legal advice in London and the South East. A record we hope to beat this year!



YOUR ROLE AS TEAM ORGANISER

As the team organiser, we rely on you to communicate with your teammates. They won't always receive the weekly updates, so please ensure you are sending the information on to your team.

SUPPORTING THE CAUSE

Upon registration, we sent you a link to your fundraising page. Please make sure all team members have that link and ask them to share it with friends, family and colleagues. We don't charge an entry fee but do suggest a minimum fundraising target of £50 per walker.

PLEASE SELF-SPONSOR

As you may know, there are considerable costs to putting an event like the London Legal Walk on. Please do your bit to chip in so LLST are not out of pocket.

We encourage all walkers to donate £20 to kickstart your fundraising. Teams who raise over £20 per walker will receive drinks tokens as a thank you from us.



ON THE DAY

REGISTRATION OPENS FROM 3PM ON CAREY STREET, AND WILL REMAIN OPEN UNTIL 7PM.

As the team organiser we request that you, or a nominated member of your team, come to sign in your team. You will be given maps and drinks tokens to distribute to your team. *See more information on page 5, Street Party Information.*



THE ROUTE:

We have three 10km routes, and two shorter routes for those that wish to participate but require a shorter distance as an adjustment .

The 10km routes take an average of 2-3 hours to complete. To ease congestion on pavements please walk 2 abreast. You do not need to tell us in advance which route you would like to take, we will have equal numbers of maps available at the registration desk. You are also welcome to follow the routes online, provided you have signed your team in at our registration desks. [View all routes.](#)

WHAT TO BRING:

Comfortable clothing and footwear. Please check the weather forecast. There will be a water station at the street party and water refill fountains in the Royal Parks. We recommend bringing a reusable bottle that you can refill at LexisNexis' water bowser. Get More Vits will also be giving away a limited amount of their vitamin water.

CLOAKROOM:

There is a cloakroom inside the Law Society. We recommend leaving any large items such as laptops locked in your office or at home. As cloakrooms can get very busy, we suggest only bringing a small bag you can take with you on the Walk.

The cloakroom will close at 9.00pm, and any left items after this will be handed to lost property.

ON THE DAY

TEAM PHOTOS

After registering, your team can have a photograph taken by one of our professional photographers. Team photos will take place between 3pm and 7pm. There isn't a booking system - simply queue up.



QUIET AREA & ACCESSIBLE SEATING

A designated quiet area will be available within the Law Society – please ask at reception, or any of the event organisers for directions on the day. We will also have an accessible seating area at the street party should you require a seat.



RAFFLE

Raffle tickets will be sold at Harvey AI's raffle stand on the day of the Walk, as well as being available to purchase [online now](#). You'll have the opportunity to win fantastic prizes including, a signed Chelsea FC shirt, signed Arsenal FC football, 6 weeks of personal training, and a wide range of meal and drinks vouchers! Tickets cost £2 and the draw will take place on Tuesday 16 June.

AUDIO SOUNDBITE RECORDINGS

We have a series of [audio sound bites](#) for the 2026 London Legal Walk. There will be 10 recordings for you to listen to and we recommend splitting them up and listening to one per KM marker reached. Each soundbite lasts between 1 minute 30 and 3 minutes. These will be accessible via QR codes that can be found on the registration desks, on posters around the street party, and on the KM markers along your route.

You can look forward to listening to messages from a variety of organisations that LLST helps, find out more about the projects LLST runs, and why the London Legal Walk is so important.

A very special welcome message from the The Rt Hon. the Baroness Carr of Walton-on-the-Hill, Chief Justice of England and Wales is included.



STREET PARTY INFORMATION

Post Walk, return to Carey Street to join in the fun of the street party. With delicious [street food](#) catering for all dietary needs, and fantastic entertainment including stilt walkers and live music it's a brilliant way to celebrate supporting access to justice. The street party finishes at 10pm.



DRINKS TOKENS

Given to teams who have raised at least £20 per walker on average as a thank you for supporting access to justice. In previous years, not every walker has raised the suggested donation, and many of those have still collected and spent their drinks tokens. Please ensure your team starts fundraising as early as possible and hits their target before Walk day.

[Drinks tokens](#) can be redeemed at the Last Judgment, The Law Society bars, and street party bars near registration desks - including stands from Toast, The Uncommon, Jewel Isle Rum Punch and The Pregnant Man (only their street stand) where you can enjoy a beer, wine or soft drink.

OR, you can donate your token back to us at the registration desk to help us raise even more for vital free legal advice charities!

VERITA'S 'BENCH BAR'

Relax and unwind at Verita's 'bench bar' after your walk. You can find this seating area situated by the registration desks at the far end of the street party.

BANNERS

We discourage the use of team banners because their use on the pavement can be disruptive to general public, and if needed for signposting they should not be inflammatory, political, controversial, divisive, or conflict with LLST's values as an inclusive organisation.

NON-LAWYERS, CHILDREN AND PETS:

The London Legal Walk is open to all, though any pets / children must be kept under supervision. Please ensure that dogs remain on their leads throughout the event, and due to crowds and other dogs being present we request that only well socialised dogs attend. Please be mindful of the temperature - Vets now caution at above 24°C, the risk of heatstroke increases significantly.

FIRST AID:

First Aid is provided by St John's Ambulance. Their contact number will be on your map. Cycle responders cover the route with a control vehicle at the street party.

ACCESSIBILITY:

River Route South and the Parks Route are accessible (there is a deep patch of gravel at Horse Guards that it is best to go around). There are also 2 shorter accessible routes for those who wish to participate and require a shorter distance as an adjustment. [View all routes](#). The Law Society building is accessible, with accessible toilets

1. MATCH FUNDING Knowing your donation will be matched is an added incentive for people to start fundraising early.

WHY WE WALK

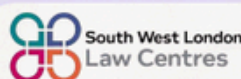
