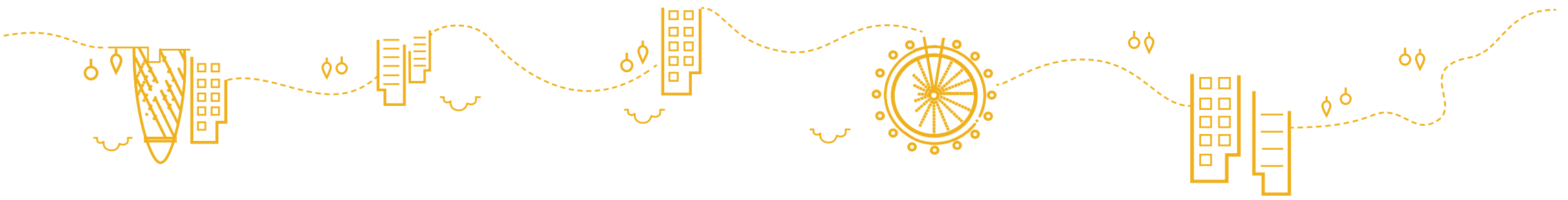

Why do we walk?

Access to justice should be a right, not a privilege. Yet in the UK today, it remains out of reach for many. Two-thirds of the population don't know how to access legal aid, and 16 million people, nearly one in four, are living in poverty, the highest level recorded in the 21st century. 26% of Londoners, and an alarming 38% of children, live in poverty, with one in six households experiencing food insecurity. These pressures have driven a 40% surge demand for free legal advice between 2018-2020 and 2024-2025. As everyday essentials become unaffordable, the justice gap continues to widen, leaving many without the support they need. Funding for free legal advice is now more urgent than ever to ensure those most affected by hardship are not denied access to justice.

Legal advice charities have worked tirelessly on the frontline to support individuals and families throughout the pandemic and beyond. Sadly, this urgent need has continued and been exacerbated by the rising cost of living and instability around the world, as people face life-changing issues around debt, housing, employment, Universal Credit, domestic violence, and more.

People need support to be able to access justice; challenge unlawful evictions, secure the care provision they are entitled to, and combat discrimination at work.

Every year, the London Legal Walk supports over 100 free legal advice charities in London and the South East. This year, they need us more than ever. 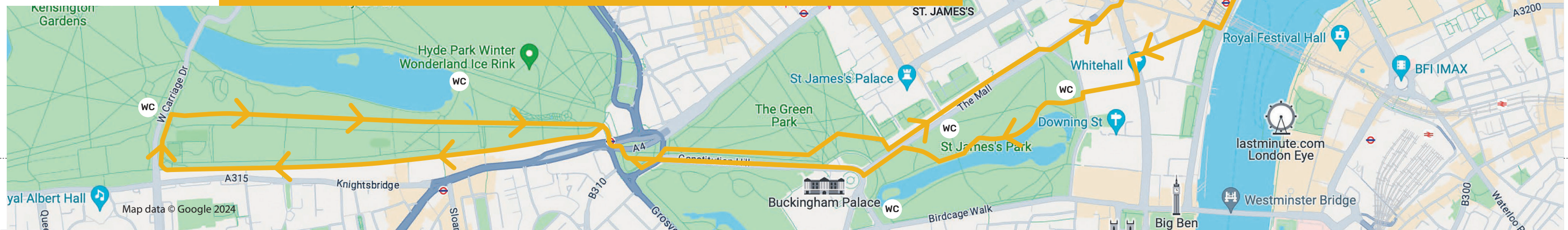
